



## **Kentucky Critical Care Transport Equivalency Courses**

The Kentucky licensed Paramedic wishing to be credentialed with a “Critical Care Endorsement” shall follow the provisions of 202 KAR 7:401 Section 8. The course shall be a minimum of eighty (80) hours in length. Courses that are not sponsored in association with the UMBC CCEMTP\* course must document that the following topics were instructed in the syllabus, objectives, or in a detailed letter and explanation from the course sponsor or the course coordinator.
