Qualifying Statement

Unless otherwise noted; disposable items that are beyond expiration date (as consistent with United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA) standards, and other applicable guidelines), equipment that is absent or nonfunctional, and equipment that is beyond the established maintenance period or usable lifespan, are deemed unsafe for patient care and constitute a deficiency violation at the time of inspection.
