

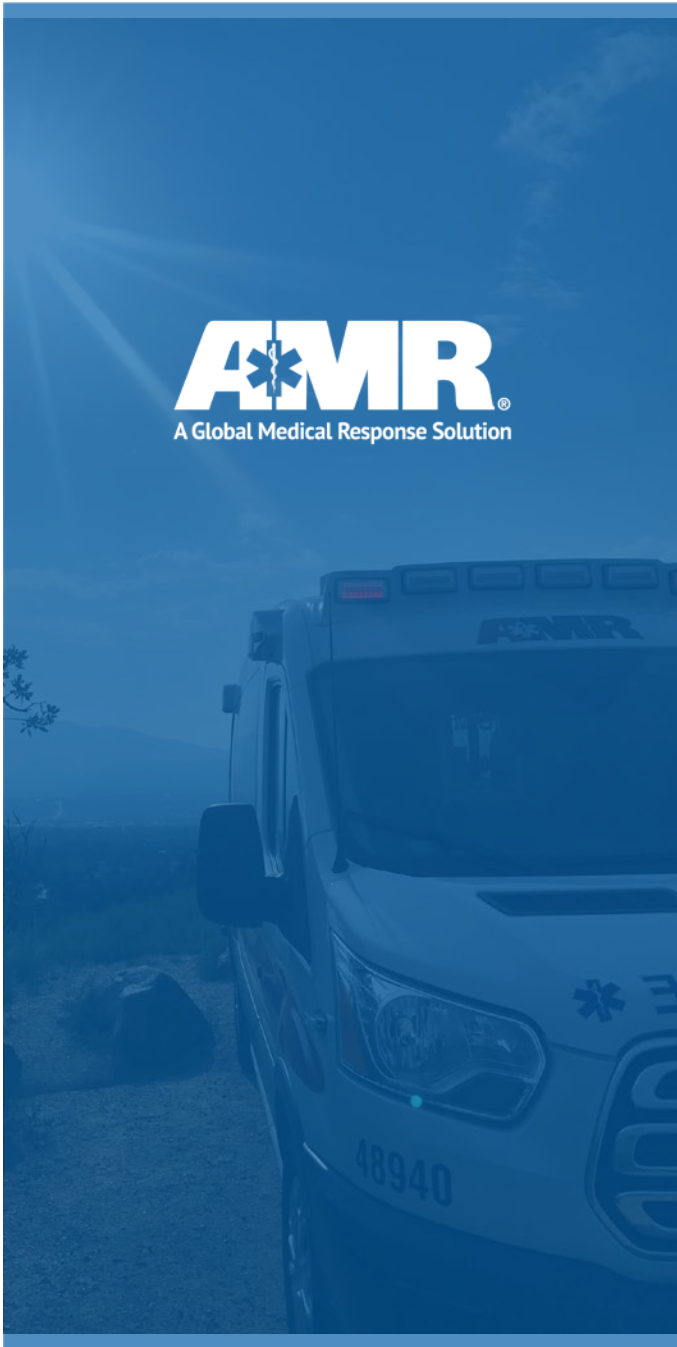

## Pediatric Fatality Review Board

- We have been a part of the Owensboro/Daviess County Pediatric Fatality Review Board for about the past 8 years or so. This board is made up of Kentucky State Police, City and County Law Enforcement Agencies, City/County attorney, Pedestrian, Nurses, Coroner, Paramedic and others. We discuss and review every aspect of the cases; most end up being accidental deaths however we are finding unnecessary and possibly preventable.

Use una superficie firme para dormir como un colchón en una cuna que cumpla con las normas de seguridad aprobadas\* y cubra el colchón con una sábana ajustable.

No use almohadas, cobijas, pieles de borrego o protectores de cuna en el lugar donde duerme el bebé.

Mantenga los objetos suaves, juguetes y ropa de cama suelta fuera del área donde duerme su bebé.

No fume ni permita que otros fumen alrededor de su bebé.

# What Does A Safe Sleep Environment Look Like?

The image below shows a safe infant sleep environment.

Baby's sleep area is in the same room, next to where parents sleep.

Use a firm and flat sleep surface, such as a mattress in a safety-approved crib\*, covered by a fitted sheet.

Baby should not sleep in an adult bed, on a couch, or on a chair alone, with you, or with anyone else.

Do not smoke or let anyone else smoke around your baby.

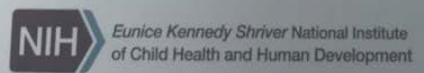


Do not put pillows, blankets, sheepskins, or bumpers anywhere in your baby's sleep area.

Remove soft objects, toys, and loose bedding from your baby's sleep area. Make sure nothing covers the baby's head.

Dress your baby in sleep clothing, such as a wearable blanket. Do not use a loose blanket, and do not overbundle.

Always place your baby on his or her back to sleep, for naps and at night.

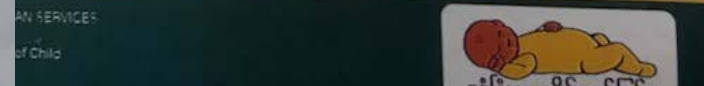

- We started about 9 years ago in stocking the Pedi-mate on our 6 frontline ambulances, since our partnership with Kentucky EMS for Children, we have extended our arsenal of pediatric transport devices, and this has opened the door for us to budget monthly funds to purchase more devices, focusing on our now 8 frontline ambulances until all 14 of our units have 1 Neo-Mate, 1 Kangoofix, 1 Pedi-mate original, and 1 Pedi-mate Plus.

- 6 – KangooFix


## Monthly Pediatric Education (EMS Life Hacks)

- In this world of COVID, we have ventured out to webinars and online learning, in the pursuit of knowledge, We ran across a presentation by Scott Deboer. I did a little research and found a series of videos he host. From this we have implemented, through our Corporate E-Learning (Success Factors) an education plan relating to pediatric care over the next two years. The series is made up of 5-minute videos, I found them extremely beneficial and short enough to keep just about anyone's attention. We have already implemented the plan, so the first of every month a module will be added to every employee's learning profile. The result, we hope will be that some of the 5 minutes worth of information will be absorbed and our providers will breath a little easier from the monthly refreshers when that pediatric call is toned out. Additionally, at the end of the two-year plan our staff will have 2-hours of pediatric education credit in addition to our existing pediatric hours.

## How to Treat 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Burns

**COOL**

- 1) Hold burned skin under cool (not cold) running water or immerse in cool water until pain subsides. Use compresses if running water isn't available.
- 2) Don't break blisters or apply butter, ointments or ice, which can cause infection.

**PROTECT**

Cover loosely with sterile, nonstick bandage and secure in place with gauze or tape.

**CARE**

- 1) Give over-the-counter pain reliever such as ibuprofen, acetaminophen, or naproxen.
- 2) Unless the person has a head, neck, or leg injury, or would cause discomfort:
