









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



Inclusion Criteria

Incident Date is Between 01/01/2020 - 12/31/2020

AND

Patient Age is Greater Than 18

AND

Response Type of Service Requested is Equal To 911 Response (Scene)

AND

Scene Incident State Name Contains Any

• Kentucky, KY

AND

Incident Complaint Reported by Dispatch Contains Any

• Heart, Overdose, Psychiatric Problem/Abnormal Behavior, Sick Person, Chest Pain, Cardiac Arrest, Breathing Problem, Unknown Problem, Unconscious, Healthcare Professional/Admission, Headache, Falls

AND

Situation Provider Primary Impression Has One of More Which is in

- ST elevation (STEMI) myocardial infarction involving left anterior descending coronary artery
- ST elevation (STEMI) myocardial infarction involving other coronary artery of anterior wall
- ST elevation (STEMI) myocardial infarction of anterior wall
- ST elevation (STEMI) myocardial infarction of inferior wall
- ST elevation (STEMI) myocardial infarction of other sites
- ST elevation (STEMI) myocardial infarction of unspecified site
