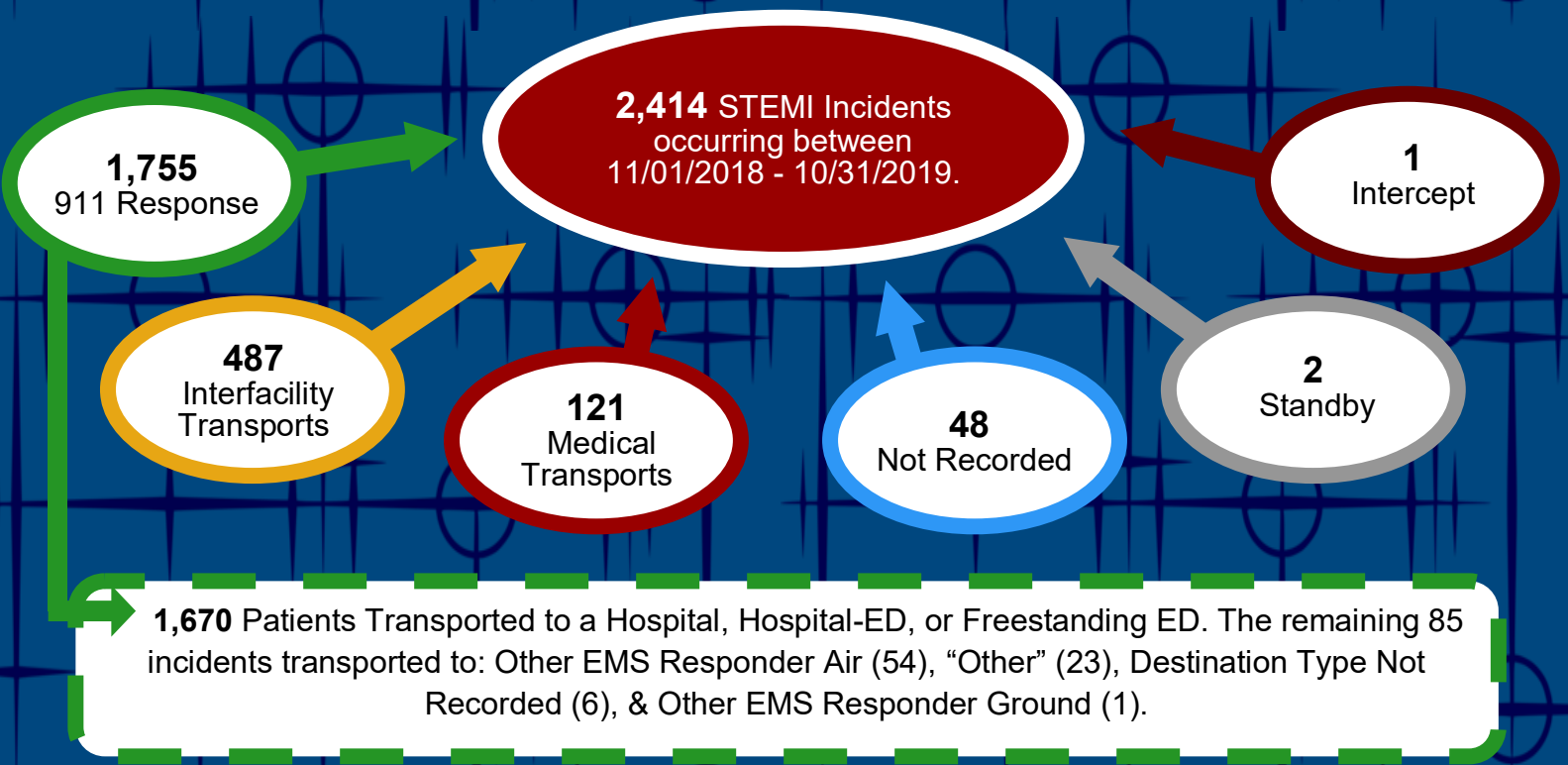




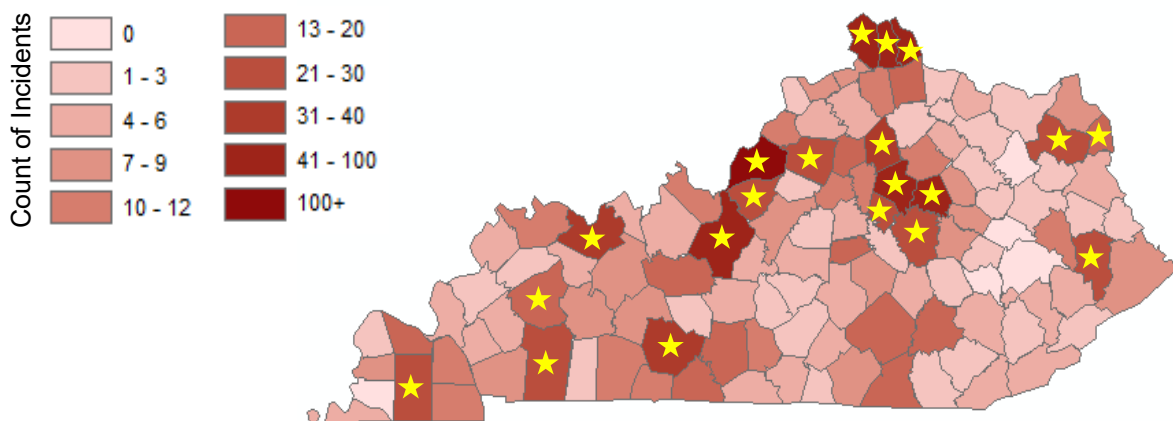

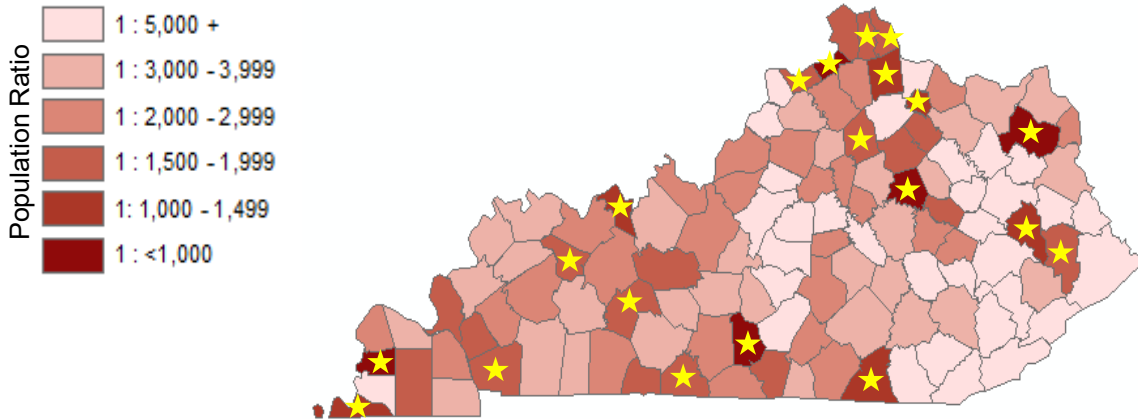

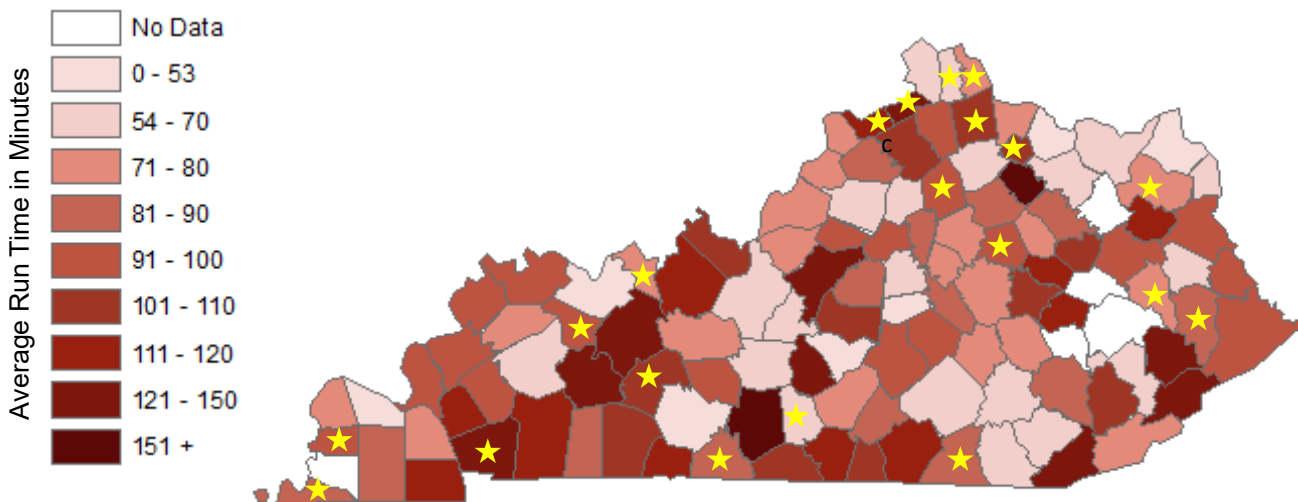
Population Ratio of Field to Hospital STEMI Incidents by Scene County within the Last 12 Months

Average Unit Notified to Unit Back in Service in Minutes for Field to Hospital STEMI Incidents



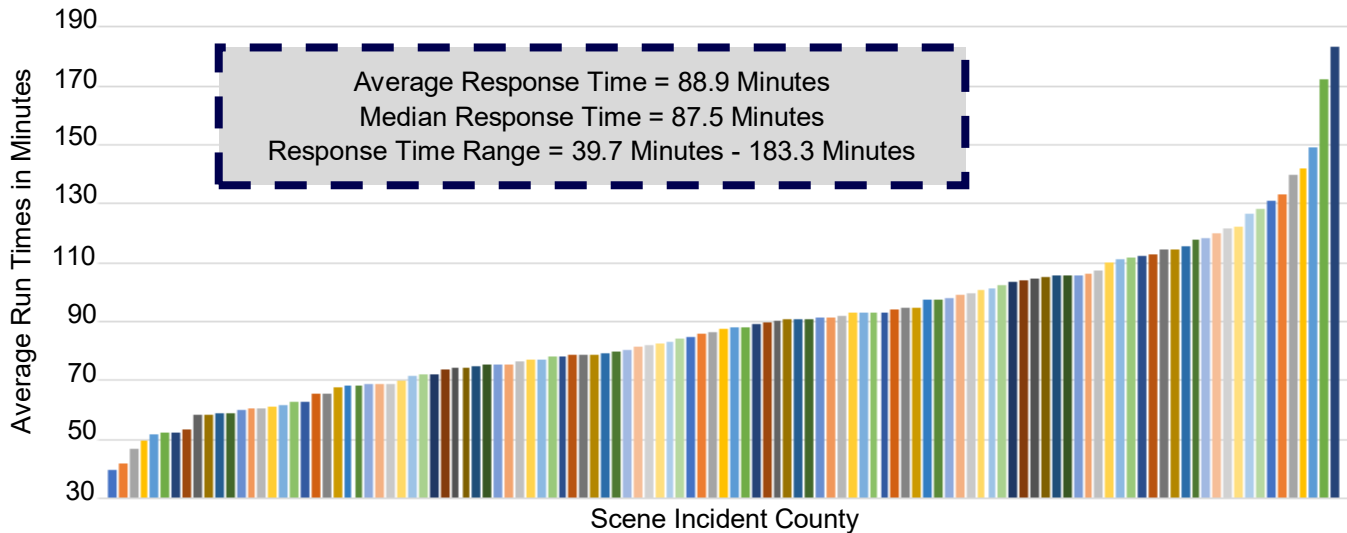

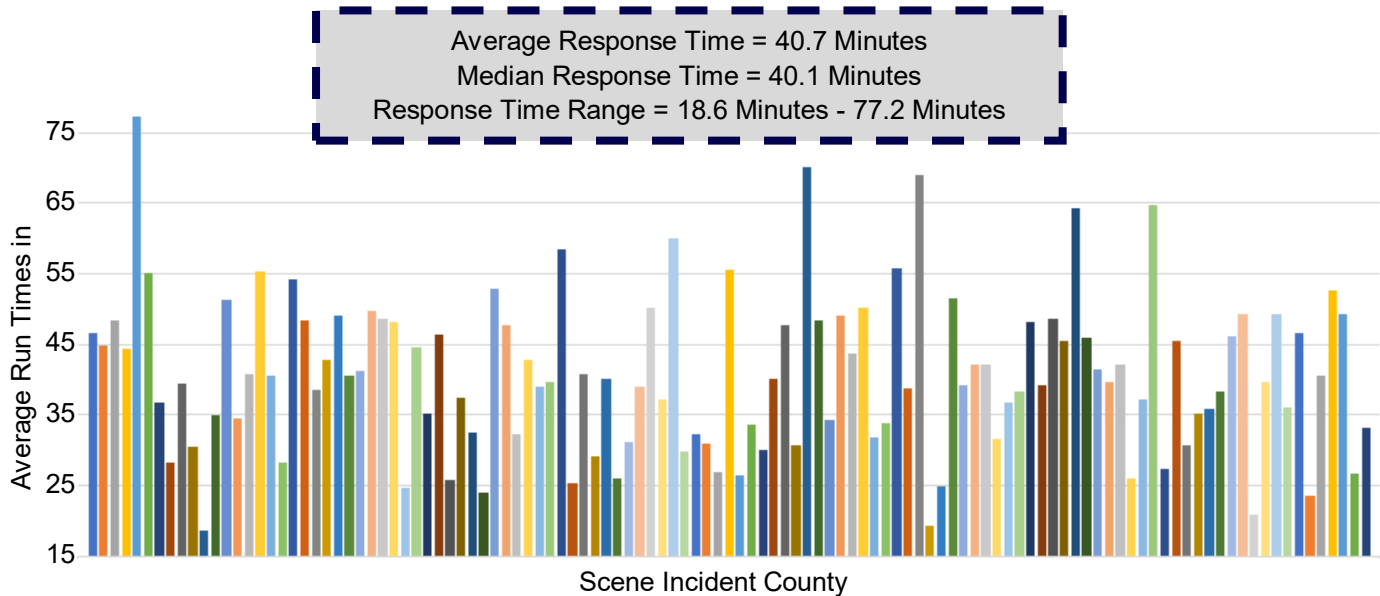
